Property orientation

This two-acre oceanfront estate is oriented to the south with coves to the east and west. It has great sunrise and sunset views and all day sun. It also has great unobstructed views of the moon rising in the east and setting in the west. The light from the moon on the water is simply spellbinding.

The estate's orientation gives it great protection from the prevailing northwest wind. This also means that the coastal fog is blown out to sea much of the time giving this property

many more days of sunshine per year. This environment allows for large expanses of gardens not possible in most coastal areas.

The splendor of this estate is very stunning. Ansel Adams has taken several photos from this property.

This is a wonderful spot for viewing whales, osprey, pelicans, seals, egrets, blue heron and otter. Timber Cove is world renown for abalone diving.

Stillwater Cove Regional Park is adjacent to the Timber Cove subdivision to the north. Fort Ross, Salt Point and Kruse Rhododendron state parks are close by. Stroll the many miles of coastal trails and through the redwoods.

Fine dining at the recently renovated Timber Cove Inn is just a short walk from the estate. The new investors are developing this historic property into a destination spa. Live music performances are frequently scheduled.
